Denny Dixon is the owner of Triple Creek Complex in McKinney. Denny is a legend in the Southwest Region for his commitment to amateur baseball and the knowledge that he is able to pass on. He was an Assistant Coach at the Univ. of North Texas before building Brookhaven JC's baseball program into one of the best in the United States as Head Coach. Denny has been giving private instruction for the past 35 years and has been a scout with the New York Mets, Arizona Diamondbacks & the Tampa Bay Devil Rays as well as a consultant to many high school and college baseball programs in Texas and surrounding states. Currently, Denny is the Head Coach at Dallas Christian University.



Bud Middaugh was head baseball coach at the University of Michigan for a decade beginning in 1980. Under his watch, the team won 9 Regular Season Big Ten Conference titles, 6 overall Big Ten Conference titles, 9 NCAA tournament berths and made four College World Series appearances. Middaugh was also an assistant coach at Miami of Ohio University in 1967 and the head coach from 1968 to 1979, before moving on to Michigan. He was 359-173 at Miami and 465-146-1 at Michigan. His career totals in college coaching was an incredible 824-319-1, a .721 winning percentage. Some of the players Bud has coached that have went on to careers in the Major Leagues are Jim Abbott, Barry Larkin, Hal Morris, Chris Sabo, Bill Doran, Steve Ontiveros, Mike Matheny and our very own Ross Powell.

Ross Powell is a part of the TCA staff and has been coaching youth baseball in McKinney for the past 7 years. Ross played amateur baseball at the University of Michigan where he compiled a 21-1 record as a left-handed pitcher. Ross was drafted in the 3rd Round of the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft as the 72nd overall pick in 1989. Ross played professional baseball for 8 years and pitched in the Major Leagues for the Cincinnati Reds, Houston Astros and Pittsburgh Pirates.

Jace Findley has been coaching youth baseball for the past 3 years in the Dallas area. Before becoming an instructor at Triple Creek, Jace was an assistant coach and instructor for the DBAT organization. Currently, Jace is coaching the 13AAA McKinney Wolves team here at Triple Creek.

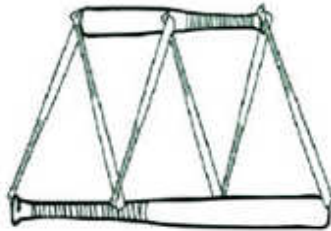
